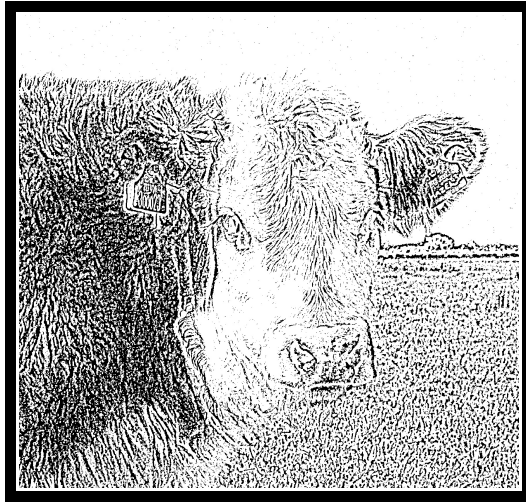

Young Handlers Classes

- Class 1** Handlers aged 14 and under on the day of the Show, leading a calf exhibited in Classes 3 to 10
- Class 2** Handlers aged 15 to 26 on the day of the Show, leading a calf exhibited in Classes 3 to 10
Champion and Reserve

The Young Handler Classes are free to enter and entries will be accepted on the day, however to give an indication of numbers it would be helpful if you could indicate any persons planning to take part on the entry form.

Prize Money - 1st £15, 2nd £12, 3rd £10, and £5 for everyone else taking part.

Breed Classes

- Class 3** Commercial Heifer or Steer by a registered Hereford sire born on or after 1st September 2010
- Class 4** Best Pair of animals born on or after 1st September 2010 owned and bred by the exhibitor
- Class 5** Bull born between 1st September 2010 and 30th November 2010
- Class 6** Bull born between 1st December 2010 and 28th February 2011
- Class 7** Bull born on or after 1st March 2011
Male Champion and Reserve
- Class 8** Heifer born between 1st September 2010 and 30th November 2010
- Class 9** Heifer born between 1st December 2010 and 28th February 2011
- Class 10** Heifer born on or after 1st March 2011
Female Champion and Reserve
Supreme Champion and Reserve

Entry Fee - £15 per class

Prize Money - 1st £40, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th £10, 5th £5

Champions £30, Reserve Champions £20

Supreme Champion £100, Reserve £50

Regulations

1. Exhibitors must comply with the current rules and regulations on Animal Gatherings and Movements in force at the time of the Show according to DEFRA and BCMS requirements, including all applicable TB pre-movement testing.
2. All exhibits in classes 4 to 10 must be registered in the Hereford Cattle Society Herd Book.
3. All information requested on the Entry Form must be provided and late entries will not normally be accepted. Entries cannot be substituted after the closing date.
4. The Association reserves the right to amalgamate classes where there are insufficient entries or split classes if considered to be oversubscribed.
5. All exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor at the entry closing date.
6. A Health Declaration form will be sent out with tickets which must be completed and accompany exhibits to the Show, along with relevant passports.
7. The cattle lines will be accessible for the arrival of exhibits after 12.00am on Saturday 12th November 2011. Exhibits arriving on Sunday 13th November 2011 must be in their stalls by 8.00am. Classes will commence at 9.00am.
8. Straw will be provided.
9. Facilities will not be provided for Dams.

Facilities and Entertainment

Bar Games will take place in the Cattle Shed from approx. 6.00pm to 8.00pm. It is hoped that exhibitors will then go over to the **Carvery, Bar and Disco** (tickets available at a discounted price of £10, if booked on your entry form).
